Course outcome of Certificate in Russian

Semester-wise course outcome for "Certificate in Russian":

Semester I:

- Grammar and Composition: Introduction to the Russian alphabet, basic vocabulary, verb conjugation, and sentence structures. Students will learn essential grammar concepts like gender, numbers, personal pronouns, and verb tenses (Past, Present, Future). Basic composition skills will be developed.
- Translation: Introduction to simple translation exercises from Russian to English/Hindi and vice versa.
- Practical Russian (Oral): Practice in speaking and listening, including retelling Russian texts and engaging in simple conversations. Students will learn to introduce themselves, talk about family and friends, and recite poems.

Semester II:

- Grammar and Composition: Further development of grammar, including reflexive verbs, adjectives, various grammatical cases (Accusative, Genitive, Dative, Instrumental), and verbs of motion. Students will practice writing short compositions.
- Translation: Continued practice in translating texts between Russian and English/Hindi.
- Practical Russian (Oral): Advanced practice in listening, speaking, and reading comprehension. Students will discuss daily life topics such as their university, town, or future aspirations. Recitation of poems and familiar dialogues will also be part of the course.

These semester-wise outcomes build a solid foundation in the Russian language, equipping students with the basic skills needed for further studies or simple communication (Syllabus Certificate).
